

ORDINANCE 78-7

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE
CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, held at the City Hall in the City of Russellville, Kentucky, on the 21st day of November, 1978, it was deemed necessary to close certain unopened streets in the Cloverland Addition to the City of Russellville, and

WHEREAS, said action is in the best interest of the residents of Russellville,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY:

I

That there be closed the following street and public way which is located in the City of Russellville, Kentucky, and described as follows, to-wit:

Being a portion of Daleview Circle beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 6, Block E, of Cloverland Subdivision as shown by a plat of record in Deed Book 172, page 463, now Plat File 67, in the office of the Clerk of the Logan County Court and including all of Daleview Circle and the two dead end streets south thereof for a distance of approximately 1,326 feet more or less in an easterly direction to the southwest corner of Lot 25 in said subdivision and being also Springdale Street extending from its terminus with Daleview Circle on the east and west thereof and being a street approximately 989 feet more or less in length and the roads to be closed are more particularly described and shown on a plat which is attached hereto, as a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "A".

That said property shall revert back to the former owners thereof, namely, Robert L. Kirkpatrick and Bobbie N. Martin, Trustees.


II

That Jesse L. Riley, Jr., for and on behalf of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, be and he is hereby authorized to institute an action in the Logan Circuit Court to have said street closed.
