

ORDINANCE NO. 92-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A
PROPERTY CLERK FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY;
WITH A SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WITNESSETH: THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of
Russellville has determined that it is in the best interest of
the City to have a specific employee designated as its property
clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE
THAT:

1) A property clerk shall be employed by the City pursuant
to KRS 98.845 and shall have the powers and responsibilities as
authorized by KRS 67.592 through 67.594.

2) The Mayor shall appoint a member of the City's police
department to this position as provided in KRS 98.845.

3) The property clerk shall not receive any additional
compensation other than the regular pay and benefits associated
with his employment as a police officer.

4) All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or
regulation in conflict herewith are here repealed to the extent
of that conflict only.

5) In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid
for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of
any other provision.

6) This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and
publication according to law.


