

ORDINANCE 94- /

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CERTAIN INTERSECTION AS A
"STOP STREET"; WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville has determined that the establishment of a certain intersection as a "Stop Street" is necessary and in the best interest of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE,
THAT:

Section 1: The following intersection is hereby established as a "Stop Street":

a) The intersection of East 3rd Street and Spring Street for vehicles traveling on 3rd Street from either direction.

Section 2) Traffic traveling along Spring Street shall not be required to stop at this intersection.

Section 3: The employees of the City are hereby directed to post stop signs at this intersection in accordance with this ordinance.

Section 4: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.

Section 5: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only. In particular, Ordinance 93-14 is hereby partially repealed regarding any reference to

3rd Street and Breathitt Street, and this Ordinance is substituted for same.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
