

ORDINANCE 98- //

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-8 "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CODIFICATION OF PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND CODIFICATION OF PERSONNEL PAY PLAN, PROVIDING FOR WAIVER THEREOF, REPEALING PRIOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS, WITH SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND EMERGENCY PROVISION" BY PROVIDING THE JOB DESCRIPTION AND PAY CLASSIFICATION FOR WATER DISTRIBUTION MANAGER, WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville has previously adopted Ordinance 83-8 "An Ordinance Adopting a Codification of Personnel Classification Plan and Codification of Personnel Pay Plan, Providing for Waiver Thereof, Repealing Prior Conflicting Ordinances and Regulations, with Severability and Emergency Provision", and the City has now determined that it is necessary and proper to amend that ordinance to provide for accurate job description for the position of Water Distribution Manager;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

Section 1: The job description for the position set forth above as attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A" is adopted for this position, and this position is classified as shown on the attachment for payment classification purposes.

Section 2: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.

Section 3: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
