

ORDINANCE 98- 3

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS IN THE AREA FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE TOWN AND COUNTRY WATER DISTRICT AND REPEALING ALL PORTIONS OF ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH TO THE EXTENT OF THAT CONFLICT ONLY, WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, THAT:

WHEREAS, the Water Works System of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, is in the process of acquiring a water system along the Highland Lick Road and along certain other county roads in that general area, which system has formerly been known as the Town and Country Water District, with the details of this project being set forth on the plans and maps on file in the city records;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and necessary at this time to establish a schedule of rates and charges for the use of and services rendered by the system to these new users;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

SECTION ONE: There is hereby established a schedule of rates and charges for the use of water services rendered by the Water Works System of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, outside the city limits in the area formerly known as the Town and Country Water District, which shall be as follows:

(1) Installation of Water Meters:

\$440 for 5/8 inch meter
500 for 1 inch meter
600 for 1-1/2 inch meter
800 for 2 inch meter.

(2) Other Water Charges: An initial deposit of \$60.00 shall be paid for new service connections. There shall be a \$40.00 reconnect fee during hours that the City Hall is open and a \$50.00 reconnect fee during hours that the City Hall is not open to reconnect any water meter that was disconnected for non-payment of charges.

(3) Monthly Water Rates:

First 2,000 gallons	\$16.40 (Minimum Bill)
Over 2,000 gallons	4.60 per 1,000 gallons

SECTION TWO: The foregoing schedule of rates and charges for the use of services rendered by the Water Works System outside of the city limits in the area formerly known as the Town and Country Water District shall be put into effect for collection of all water bills becoming due on or after February 10, 1998.

SECTION THREE: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

SECTION FOUR: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication according to law. An emergency is hereby declared to exist due to the requirement of the Public Service Commission and the Kentucky Division of Water relating to the sale and operation of this water district, and the requirement of a second reading is waived and suspended.


