## ORDINANCE NO. 99-3

## ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, STATING ITS INTENTION TO REZONE A TRACT OF LAND ON THE MORGANTOWN ROAD IN THE CITY LIMITS, FROM R4 TO INDUSTRY, SAID TRACT OF RECORD IN DEED BOOK 298, PAGE 517, IN THE LOGAN COUNTY COURT CLERK'S OFFICE

WITNESSETH: THAT WHEREAS, the City of Russellville has received a recommendation from the Joint Logan County & Cities Planning Commission that after a public hearing held on February 22, 1999, to request a rezoning of a tract of land on the Morgantown Road, a plat of which is attached hereto, from R4 to Industry, at the request of Darrell E. Paschall, and the Commission having heard the request and looked at the application and finding that it made a complete finding of fact supporting the zoning change, and the Commission having voted unanimously to approve the zoning change and having recommended that the City Council adopt the change,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, that:

- 1) The City of Russellville, Kentucky does hereby rezone a tract of land on the Morgantown Road and more particularly described in Deed Book 298, Page 517, in the Logan County Court Clerk's Office, and as attached hereto by Plat from R4 to Industry and does hereby amend the zoning map to reflect that rezoning.
- 2) In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.
- 3) All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
  - 4) This ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication according to law.
