ORDINANCE NO. 99-4

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 98-17, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY"

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville voted at the City Council meeting held on March 3, 1999, to join an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement to provide a county wide emergency operation center to include an Enhanced 911 System,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

- Section I: That Ordinance 98-17, passed December 8, 1998, relating to the establishment of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone service within the City of Russellville, Kentucky, is repealed.
- Section 2: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.
- Section 3: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule of regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
