

**CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE 2024-01**

**AN ORDINANCE EQUATING THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE MAYORIAL  
COMPENSATION PURSUANT TO KRS 83A.075 AND THE KENTUCKY  
DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT**

WHEREAS, KRS Chapter 83A sets forth legal authority for compensation for Mayors in Kentucky; AND

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.075 requires the Kentucky Department for Local Government to compute annually the increase or decrease in the consumer price index of the preceding year for use in equating the compensation for Mayors; AND

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department for Local Government has determined that the consumer price index increase for 2023 was 3.4%; AND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Russellville, Kentucky as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 2024, the current annual salary of the Mayor shall be increased by 3.4%, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 83A.075 and the most recent Kentucky Department of Local Government cost of living adjustment released on January 29, 2024.
2. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any particular state of case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this Ordinance, it being the legislative intent of this body to ordain and in act each other.

3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith now in effect, to the extent of said conflict, are hereby repealed.
4. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
