## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application from the city of Russellville for the repairs to the Town Creek Retaining Wall. Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published July 23, 2024, for DR-4804-KY Severe Storms, Straight-Line Winds, Tornadoes, Landslides, and Mudslides. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project- specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within a Special Flood Hazard Area. FEMA has determined that the only practicable alternative is to fund the repairs of the Town Creek Branch-Retaining Wall, already located within a Floodplain Area prior to the event.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

**Proposed Work and Purpose:** The applicant will utilize contract and (or) force account for exterior repairs to Town Creek Branch Retaining Wall to restore this facility to its pre-disaster design, function, and capacity within the existing footprint. Replacement (1) Replacing 2.22 CY of Concrete retaining wall, 12 FT long x 10 IN wide x 6 FT deep. Replacement of 10.67 CY of Embankment Unclassified fill, 12 FT long x 8 FT wide x 6 FT deep.
